- a. Classroom tested materials, supplemented with up-to-date material that may relate to Atlantic salmon issues and troubleshooting for the units
- b. volunteer component, with some differences in delivery in each jurisdiction
- c. 630 schools Connecticut to Labrador, with approximately 250 volunteers.
- d. Equipment: Aquarium as large as possible to cushion temperature change – 100 Litres nice; different chillers available in North America
